### NEW RAMP COMING SOON!

The existing ramp on the Allen Ave side of the church has served us well for 30 or so years. However, it has now reached the end of its useful life. The Vestry, at their March 24 meeting, voted to have a new ramp constructed at the corner of North Main & Allen. (See the drawings posted in the undercroft.) The work will be done by Blissville Custom Woodworking and should cost no more than \$11,000. Funds are available to cover the cost of the project. However, donations are gladly accepted to reduce the amount to be withdrawn from our investments.
